Key Stage	Topic	Workshop
Early Years KS1	Drama	Traditional Tales – interactive story sessions using drama as a tool to bring the stories to life, from Gingerbread man to little red riding Hood and many more these session use drama to allow the children to become the characters and create their own version of the story.
Early years KS1 KS2	Drama / Literacy	Drama Storytelling We can help bring literacy to life with our storytelling sessions! We offer a range of workshops that are suitable from Nursery all the way through to KS2. The sessions are all led by experienced storytellers who bring a variety of tales to the table. Let us know of your topic this term and we can deliver a drama workshop to suit your class. These can be based on a popular author or book
Early years KS1 KS2	Visual Arts Drama	Fire of London - Take part in our hands-on workshop. Create your own london house and then use the drama to re-act live events of what happened on that terrible night.
KS2	Visual Arts	Drawing and Mark Making - Explore mark-making with a huge range of materials and make drawings with new media.
KS2	Visual Arts	Developing Colour - Learn about colour theory and painting techniques by studying how artists use light and colour and then having a go yourself!
KS2	Visual Arts	Shape and Form - Transform 2D drawings into 3D forms and sculptures using different materials.
